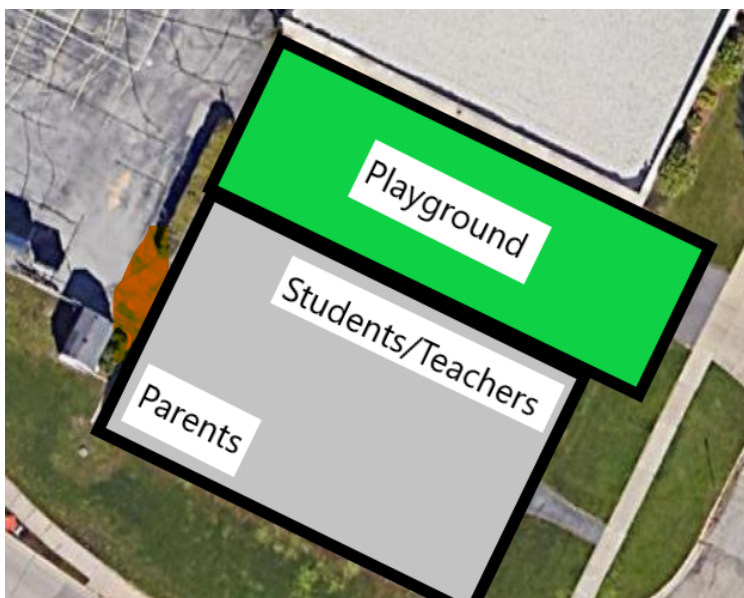
From the Principal
